Ok Tedi Mining Limited (OTML) is a State-owned company that operates an open-pit copper, gold and silver mine located in the Star Mountains of Western Province, Papua New Guinea (PNG).

The company's success is measured on its economic performance, human resource development programmes, zero harm safety performance, and the management and mitigation of its environmental impacts.

Our Project

OTML were facing significant challenges with their aging Ellipse application server environment. The hardware platforms were 7-8 years old and had reached their limits from both supportability as well as spare parts availability. OTML had already invested in a multi-million dollar server farm to support their entire corporate application landscape including their Ellipse version 6 environments. The scope included development, testing, training and production servers. OTML owned and hosted both the old and new infrastructure internally and had the opportunity to perform an Ellipse upgrade, however an Ellipse 'as-is' move strategy was adopted to allow extra time for the decision making process on the future ERP direction.

COSOL were engaged to 'virtualise' this environment so that ALL Ellipse services and instances could be moved to the new infrastructure.
